2017 Hometown Manitoba Program Announced

The Portage & District Chamber of Commerce, in conjunction with the City of Portage la Prairie has established a meaningful partnership with respect to the business enhancements. Hometown Manitoba is a Provincial program and is now administered by the Department of Indigenous and Municipal Relations-Community Planning and Development Division. The Hometown Main Streets Enhancements program provides financial support for rural community projects initiated by local communities, organizations, cooperatives and businesses that enhance “main street” public places and building exteriors. The program also aims to promote unique identities and themes that define a community.

The Chamber’s goal is to engage the business community to take “Pride in Portage, Pride in our People” by taking personal responsibility and action in contributing to community improvement. The overall theme for eligible businesses is to take action to enhance the appearance of businesses, incorporating concepts that reflect the rich heritage of our area through appropriate streetscaping and exterior business look.

Hometown Manitoba provides matching funds up to 50% of total eligible projects to a maximum of \$1,000. Over the last 10 years, the City has participated in this program with grants available from a total fund of \$10,000. This support clearly demonstrates the City’s commitment to assisting businesses in their efforts to improve the look of their business exteriors.

2017 Hometown Manitoba Program Notice!

GRANTS AVAILABLE TO DOWNTOWN AND “MAIN STREET” BUSINESSES

If your business or organization is located:

- on Saskatchewan Avenue and 2 blocks North and South of Saskatchewan Avenue, or
- on Provincial Hwy 240 within City limits

you may be eligible to access matching funds under the Hometown Manitoba Program as well as from the City of Portage for exterior building improvements and/or landscaping projects. Since 2007, approximately 100 businesses have shared in grants to assist the completion of \$550,000 in projects designed to enhance the exterior appeal of their businesses. \$67,000 was approved under the Hometown Manitoba Main Streets Enhancement program and another \$90,000 through funds made available by the City of Portage la Prairie.

Details on how to access these grants and what eligibility requirements must be met are detailed below. **Deadline for local application submission is Friday, September 8, 2017** in order that all applications can be forwarded to the Province prior to the final September 11, 2017 deadline. Work cannot begin until approval is confirmed, which the province has stated will be end of October 2017. **Projects that must be completed by March 31, 2018.** Applications are available for pick up at the Chamber office or City Hall.

The Portage & District Chamber of Commerce, in conjunction with the City of Portage la Prairie has established a meaningful partnership with respect to business enhancements. Hometown Manitoba is a Provincial program and is administered by the Department of Indigenous and Municipal Relations-Community Planning and Development Division. The Hometown Main Streets Enhancements program provides financial support for rural community projects initiated by local communities, organizations, cooperatives and businesses that enhance “main street” public places and building exteriors. The program also aims to promote unique identities and themes that define a community.

Hometown Main Streets Enhancements will contribute up to 50% of total eligible projects costs, to a maximum of \$1,000. The applicant will make up the balance of eligible costs, in cash. In-kind costs are not eligible and the Provincial deadline for applications is September 11, 2017. Specific programs details are outlined in the Hometown Manitoba Program Guide and application form. These are available for pick up at the Chamber office and City Hall. Included with the application is a partially filled out application to assist you in your completion.

Eligibility criteria include the following:

- The project applicant must be a small business, non-profit community organization or cooperative.
- Individual projects must be part of an overall community enhancement initiative.
- The project must be located in a public place within the “main street” area.
- The project must help to advance a community theme or identity.

In addition, projects may involve local artists in public art projects such as building murals, permanent banners and sculptures, provided they are part of a broader project that supports a community identity, cultural, heritage or tourism theme.

The City of Portage la Prairie has supported this program in previous years through a \$10,000 pool of funds which was also available on a matching basis for Hometown approved projects. These funds will be awarded based on the following eligibility criteria:

- Applicant has been approved under the Hometown Main Streets Enhancements Program and located within City of Portage limits.
- Applicant's cash contribution must be equal to, or greater than, the amount approved under the Hometown Main Streets Enhancements Program.
- The City will match the funds approved under the Hometown Main Streets Enhancements Program, subject to the \$1,000 individual maximum and the \$10,000 maximum funding available.
- If the total applications approved exceed the \$10,000 maximum, funds will be awarded on a pro-rata basis. (e.g. if approved applications total \$11,000 funds would be pro-rated at a 90% level).
