SASKATCHEWAN AVENUE WEST IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

While the water and sewer renewals on the Saskatchewan Ave West improvement project will mostly be completed in 2022, the roadway work for the avenue will be completed in stages over the next two years, with project completion expected in 2024.

The end result will be an impressive west entrance to our city, better traffic controls on this busy avenue, newly paved parking for businesses and avenue residents and ways to bike or walk in the area without navigating gravel shoulders.

WINTER LANDFILL HOURS

The Portage la Prairie Regional Landfill has switched over to their winter hours of operation. It is now open Monday through Saturday, from 8:30am to 4:30pm. These hours will remain in effect until March 31st, 2023.

The Portage la Prairie Regional Landfill wants to remind the public that there is no trespassing and no hunting allowed on the Landfill site. Your cooperation in helping to keep the customers and the staff of the Landfill safe is appreciated.

To ensure all your waste makes it to the Landfill and to accomplish the goal of clean roadways:

1. All loads must be tarped and strapped so that nothing comes loose on your way to the Landfill.
2. Monitor your load at all times and stop and secure your load if necessary.
3. After unloading your waste, be sure all debris and nails are cleaned off and tail gates are closed before pulling away from the dumping area.

The Landfill will be enforcing our \$60.00 penalty for untarped loads so please take the time to secure your load properly.

ROUTINE SNOW CLEARING

The City of Portage la Prairie reminds citizens that routine snow clearing takes place on the day after garbage collection when snow accumulation has met set standards. Parking in violation of By-Law No. 20-8705 is subject to a fine.

Our City crews work as fast as possible to remove snow from the streets, but unfortunately, parked cars can get in our way. If we have to tow some cars to make winter driving safe for everyone, we will, but we would rather not. So please, to avoid having your car towed, you should not park on the street during snow clearing operations.

TICKET AND TOW

If your car is parked on any street during a citywide parking ban, it will be ticketed, at a cost outlined in the current Fees and Charges Schedule. As well, your vehicle could be towed to the nearest cleared street.

DRIVEWAY SNOW CLEARING

Snow being blown, shoveled or pushed onto City streets is not permitted. All residents should adhere to the City's Traffic By-Law No. 20-8705.
